Salvation Army's EnergyShare heating program assists individuals living in Spotsylvania, Stafford, King George, Caroline and the city of Fredericksburg with heating bills. This program includes all fuel types: propane, natural gas, wood, kerosene, electric, etc.

Eligibility requirements:

- Must have exhausted all other state and federal resources.
- Disconnection notice required except for age 60 or older
- Experiencing a family or personal crisis which has occurred within the past thirty days
- Income eligible

Copies of photo identification and social security cards for adult household members and social security and birthdates for all children, as well as verification of ALL household income is required!

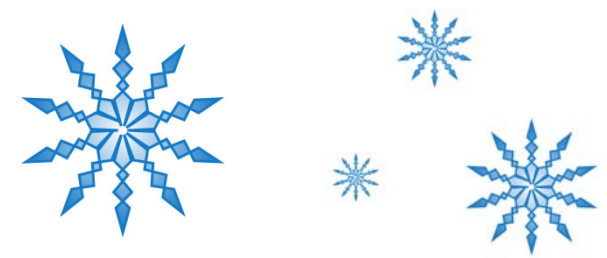

Need help to stay warm this winter?



Local Departments of Social Services have an Energy Assistance Program that assists low-income households, particularly those with the lowest incomes that pay a high proportion of household income for home energy. It is comprised of three winter related components:

- Fuel Assistance—helps with the cost of heating
- Crisis Assistance—helps when fuel assistance and other resources do not meet the need
- Weatherization Assistance—Assists with energy efficiency and air infiltration
