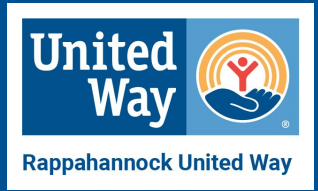


2017-2018 Community Impact Fund EDUCATION Investments



OUTCOMES - RUW funds local programs seeking to address the following areas:

Birth to 5 years
Parents develop positive behaviors that support children (birth-5 years) in achieving developmental milestones

Parents & students develop behaviors that demonstrate the value of education and lead to graduation
