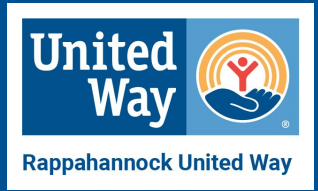

Positive Financial Practices

Families and households sustain financial self-reliance through positive financial practices.
