Rappahannock United Way Kicks Off Women United With Keynote Speaker Jeannette Walls.

Fredericksburg, VA (December 4, 2019) – Rappahannock United Way launched their new affinity group, Women United, with a business luncheon held at Gari Melchers Studio Pavilion. Hosted by Rappahannock United Way's Women United Leadership Council (WULC) and attended by over 120 women, the WULC was honored to host Jeannette Walls as their keynote speaker. A celebrated author, Walls is best known for her #1 New York Times best-selling memoir, "The Glass Castle," which details her life growing up in extreme poverty and the tale of her emergence from it. Named by Amazon as one of the top 10 books of the decade, her inspiring story was brought to the big screen in the 2017 major motion picture, *The Glass Castle*. Walls shared her unforgettable journey of overcoming unrelenting adversity and discussed how each person has the power to turn their greatest weakness into their greatest strength.

Jeannette's story tied into Rappahannock United Way's focus for Women United; women helping women overcome adversity and achieve success in the workplace. "Through intensive study United Way has identified possible barriers for women in our community who are Asset Limited, Income Constrained and Employed (ALICE). Top on the list of barriers are: childcare, transportation, work certification and stable housing.
