Household Gross Income:

Household Income Includes:

- Income for all adult members of the household
- Income from earned wages, unemployment, benefits, child/spousal support, etc.

Gross Income means the total amount before all deductions such as taxes, benefits, etc.

Recent (current month) pay stubs or other income statements must be provided to verify income for all adults in household.

To qualify for Stafford County government / public schools housing assistance, employee's household income must be equal to or lesser than the Area Median Income for Stafford County, VA.

Area Median Income:

The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) sets income limits that determine eligibility for assisted housing programs including the Public Housing, Section 8 project-based, Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher, Section 202 housing for the elderly, and Section 811 housing for persons with disabilities programs. HUD develops income limits based on Median Family Income estimates and Fair Market Rent area definitions for each metropolitan area, parts of some metropolitan areas, and each non-metropolitan county.
