Household Income at or below ALICE Survival Budget Threshold

Strategic Plan Goals:

- Create a shared agenda as it relates to the local ALICE population/issues in RUW's focus areas of Education, Financial Stability and Healthy Living.
- Work specifically in the areas of Education/Graduation; Job Skills/Income; Financial Stability; Resilience/Safety; Healthy and Ready to Learn.
- Strengthen and create programs internally to meet the necessary outcomes in the above areas and/or fund local programs and partners that meet the necessary outcomes in the above areas.
- Grow the ALICE Assistance Program/Fund to support the areas of Housing Assistance, Transportation, Childcare and Workforce Certifications.
- Increase revenue by creating products that allow RUW to diversify revenue and engage donors in the work RUW does internally.
- Execute hiring a RD Coordinator, a Navigator (Financial Stability, Coaching), an Intake Coordinator (ALICE Assistance), Education Manager (Grade Level Reading, Workforce Credentials)

Healthy & Ready to Learn

Outcome: Children (Birth through 5) will achieve health and developmental milestones and be kindergarten-ready.

Indicators:

% of children (rising Kindergartners) served who are proficient on school readiness assessments

% of children (0-5) who achieve developmental milestones

% of at-risk children who improve on mental health measurement scales

Program Outputs:

of early childhood staff trained to provide quality programs & services

of children enrolled in high-quality early childhood programs

of families, caregivers served that are provided with information, resources, tools, trainings, and/or teaching skills

children that meet key developmental milestones (0-5 years)

infants up to date with age appropriate immunizations

at-risk infants and toddlers experience fewer mental, emotional and / or behavioral symptoms



Success in School

Outcome: Families will support children's successful progress through school

Indicators:

- % grade level reading by 3rd grade / improvement in local school readiness rates
- % improvement in high school completion / graduation
- % of youth who develop soft skills
- % of students (3-12) who maintain or improve school attendance
- % of children reading at grade level

Program Outputs:

- # of children served receiving literacy supports K-3
- # of youth who participate in school or community based out-of-school time programs or receive individualized support
- # of children who maintain or improve attendance
- # with grade level reading skills
- # with grade level math skills
- # on time grade level transitions
- # complete internships, apprenticeships
- # obtain college readiness skills
- # graduate high school on time
- # access 2, 4-year college or CTE Certifications



Self Sufficient – Financial Stability through Employment:

Outcome: Individuals will succeed in today's workplace

Indicators:

% of individuals who increase their wages

attain family sustaining wages

retain job for 6 months

gain upward mobility

% of individuals in programs who earn job-relevant licenses, certificates, or credentials

of households who achieve financial stability per local ALICE Thresholds

Program Outputs:

- # of individuals who receive job skills training
- # enroll in credentialing programs
- # enroll in job / vocational training
- # obtain job readiness skills
- # of individuals provided employment services
- # complete job training
- # complete entrepreneurship programs
- # complete internships or apprenticeships
- # graduate credentialing programs



Self Sufficient – Financial Resiliency through Positive Practices:

Outcome: Individuals will build self-sufficiency

Indicators:

% improvement in population achieving financial stability per ALICE Thresholds

% of households substantially improve financial strength

increase income, savings, assets

reduce debt

improve credit worthiness

% of individuals in programs who increase their disposable income by accessing benefits and/or reducing their costs

Program Outputs:

of households obtain / maintain stable living situation

of households obtain / maintain quality childcare

of households obtain / maintain reliable transportation

of households substantially increase income, reduce costs or improve access to resources

access ALICE funded resources / supports

substantially reduce costs (fees, interest rate)

leverage financial products

of individuals who access affordable housing, financial products and services

of financial sector staff trained to deliver quality services

of individuals file tax returns / access tax credits

of individuals gain knowledge about personal finance

Healthy Living:

Outcome: Individuals and families will demonstrate a sustained ability to avoid, withstand, and recover from adverse events.

Indicators:

% of individuals served accessing healthcare services

% of individuals who develop coping, stress management, and resilience skills

% of individuals served who demonstrate improvement on accepted Mental Health measurement scales

% of individuals who adopt health behaviors

Program Outputs:

- # gain knowledge about healthy lifestyle habits/conditions
- # gain strategies for enhancing safety
- # develop coping, stress management, resilience skills
- # develop strategies to respond to bullying / abusive behaviors
- # avoid using illegal substances
- # develop positive / healthy relationships
- # improve level of functioning mentally, emotionally
- # increase sense of community safety and connection
- # reduce unhealthy days
- # decrease school / work absenteeism
- # free from law enforcement / juvenile justice involvement
- # free from substantiated incidents of abuse / neglect
